This **Stepwell** is built over a thousand years ago in the Abhaneri village of Rajasthan. It is one of the largest stepwells in the world and one of the most beautiful ones.

Later, proceed to Jaipur. You will reach the Jaipur by late afternoon.

Rest of the day is at leisure.

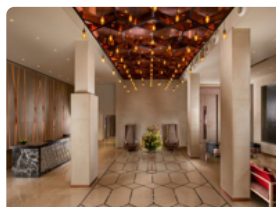
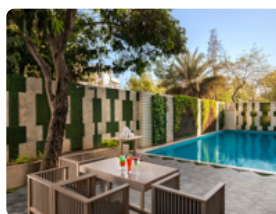
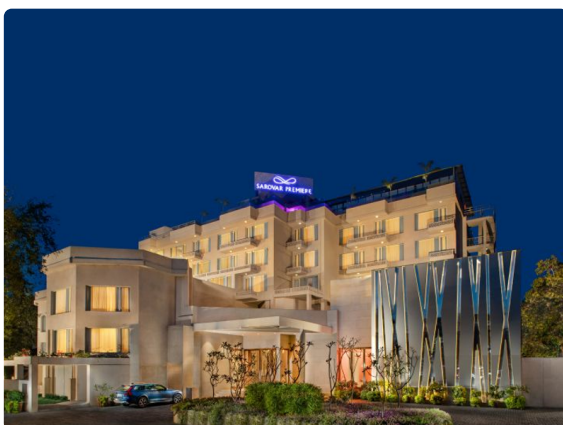

### Flower Market - Govind Ji Temple Morning Rituals

This morning, visit the **Flower Market and Govind Ji Temple**.

Probably one of the most significant temples for Krishna followers after Vrindavan, Govind Dev Temple is located within the **City Palace of Jaipur**.

Built during the reign of Emperor Akbar by Sawai Man Singh in 1590 and was regarded as being one of the largest temples of the world during its time.

Witness the **Mangala Aarati Ceremony** at dawn.

As the Temple is the part of the City Palace, which was the seat of the Maharaja of Jaipur, it has a beautiful coexistence of Hindu, Muslim and Western architectural traits. The temple is surrounded by beautiful gardens. Inside it, one can see some beautiful European chandeliers and paintings of Indian art.



### Diwali Celebration with Local Family

Congratulations on making the right decision to witness the **festival of lights** first-hand here in Jaipur. Diwali is India's 'Festival of Light', a time when people come together to celebrate good conquering evil, light conquering dark.

Post healthy breakfast, we will take you to the local markets to shop for fireworks and local sweets as during Diwali sweets are a traditional gift. Your leader will point out which sweets to choose and their significance.

After local shopping and lunch come back to your hotel for a relaxing afternoon.
